

FELT BANNERS FOR FIRST COMMUNION

The banners should represent the spirit of the celebration of the Eucharist.

Banners should include your child's first name, date of the ceremony, and other symbols that represent the blood and body of Christ. For example, wheat symbolizes bread, grapes or the chalice for wine, the Host for the Last supper, etc. We have had very creative banners over the years. Leave 6 inches open at the top of the finished banner to allow them to be attached to the pews.



Bring the finished banner to First Holy Communion rehearsal on Friday, May 2nd as we will attach them to the reserved pews at that time. Your child, and family members, will sit in the pew where their banner is attached.

We hope you have fun doing this with your child. Use felt, glitter, or whatever other decorative items you wish! Your child will take their banner home after First Holy Communion Weekend as a remembrance keepsake.
